## We need

- i) Water Sufficient potable water at affordable cost.
- ii) **Drainage** Effective and functioning drainage system
- iii) **Health care** Functioning government hospitals with medicines and doctors who can take care of people, especially poor.
- iv) **Education** Functioning and standard government schools and colleges.
- v) **Slum improvement** About 30 lakh people in 1500 slums are living in deplorable conditions They need immediate relief.
- vi) **Transport** Effective public transport system in core area and connectivity with far-flung colonies around city.

- vii) Uninterrupted power supply Low power tariff to poor and middle class
- viii) **Efficient public distribution system** People should get quality provisions with proper weight.
- ix) **Pollution free city** Air pollution due to vehicular traffic is increasing by day and causing health problems Control on Air pollution
- x) Polluting industries including plastic industries in and around city to be shifted or closed effective implementation of pollution control laws.
- xi) Clearing of foot paths and encouraging residents to use of foot paths. 40% of the road accidents are due to pedestrians walking on the roads.
- xii) Effective solid waste management plan Speedy collection of solid waste generated in the city, proper dumping yard facilities generating energy, fertilizers etc. from solid waste.
- xiii) Security to life and property effective, efficient and people friendly police.
- xiv) Professional municipal cadre replacing the current unresponsive corrupt municipal officialdom.
- xv) Making citizens participation an integral part of planning and implementation of the programme.
- xvi) Reforms to Municipal Act to control corruption and to prevent encroachments and irregular constructions.
- xvii) **Parks** In every municipal ward there should be a playground and a park

Forum for Good Governance feels that the felt needs of the people should have priority over scheme prepared by the GHMC. Incidentally many other departments like water board, R&B, electricity, civil supplies are not involved in preparation of action plan, it is like a GHMC plan.
