Sub : Higher Education – Serious irregularities committed by Narayana & Sri Chaitanya colleges – Inquiry conducted by V&E department – Higher Education Department not taking any action on V&E Department report – Reg.

Vigilance & Enforcement Department, Government of Telangana has conducted enquiry on malfunctioning of corporate colleges especially Narayana and Sri Chaitanya Colleges located in and around Hyderabad and submitted their report.

In their findings the Vigilance & Enforcement Department observed that :

1. These institutions are not adhering to rules and regulations in running the colleges
2. Running additional classes without any permission
3. Collecting excess fee from the students


4. Admitting more than permitted strength in each class.
5. Fire safety measures not taken
6. Not following the rules of reservation
7. Inspecting officials and Board officials not taking steps to curb the violation
8. There is a provision for penalty for violation committed by the colleges, V&E Department has calculated the violations for one year 2009-10 and estimated as Rs.1 Crore 38 Thousands.
9. In single Saroornagar mandal, Narayana Education Society is running 20 colleges which is against the rule of prevention of monopoly of the corporate colleges.
10. Most of the colleges are not having library and play ground facilities.

Vigilance & Enforcement Department also gave recommendations to set right the things. Since last 5 years there is no action on the inquiry report of Vigilance & Enforcement. We have requested for information regarding action taken. In the year 2015 it was informed that matter is under examination. Again after 5 years we again asked information regarding action taken, the information given is "The report received on Narayana and Sri Chaitanya Colleges is under examination.

When D.G., Vigilance & Enforcement inquired and submitted his report action should have been initiated for the lapses committed by these institutions, but the Higher Education Department is dragging its feet to take action.

Forum for Good Governance has a reason to believe that Higher Education Department in Secretariat is acting like a God father to these two institutions and not initiating any action on the serious irregularities committed by them. The Chief Secretary, Govt. of Telangana is requested to kindly issue suitable instructions for taking up action on the irregularities pointed out by V& E Department.
