Sub: Yadadri Temple – Damage to ghat road and other areas in Temple premises – Request for inquiry – Reg.

One rain of about 8 cm. on 4<sup>th</sup> of May has caused immense damage to Yadadri temple premises and the ghat road. If this is the situation in summer what will happen to the temple in rain season is the worry of people.

During last 6 years, it appears close to Rs. 1200 crores were spent on construction of this temple. There is lot of stories making rounds that nepotism in allotting works to contractors, corruption, undue hast in completion of certain works and frequent modifications in execution lead to substandard work.

Yadadri temple is a second Tirupathi for the people of Telangana and it is a rude shock to see the huge damage caused with one rain. The temple has to remain there for centauries to come, but the damage sustained with single shower in summer is causing doubts on the stability of the temple.

Prl. Secretary, Roads & Building is requested to kindly order for detailed inquiry by D.G. V&E for the lapses and take immediate steps for repairs.
